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New Issue Notes

2016 Matariki IX - Kete Design (1 June 2016)

Here we have the ninth annual release celebrating the dawn of the Maori New Year or Matariki. Kete are traditional Maori baskets most commonly woven from New Zealand flax. Functionally kete are containers – receptacles for gathering and housing what Maori considered necessary for the task at hand. Today kete have developed into a contemporary artform and six kete artworks have been selected by Maori Arts New Zealand Toi Maori Aotearoa for these stamps.

Designs

- **\$1.00** A kete taniko created by Cori Marsters by warp and weft weaving or whatu. Reminiscent of a genre of kete from around the early 1900s, this kete utilizes patterns of ducks' feet or waewae parera and serpent's teeth or niho taniwha.
- **\$1.00** This is a kete whiri or basket with plaited bottom executed in a sculptural and three-dimensional form by Pip Devonshire. By mixing traditional and non-traditional forms Pip has elevated her kete from being practical and functional to a work of art.
- **\$1.80 Master weaver Te Atiwei Ririnui** has here created by plaiting and twining a kete featuring an exceptionally difficult male lineage design or poutama.
- **\$2.20 Most kete designs are symmetrical** but here we have an experimental non-symmetrical design from Audra Potaka embodying Mt Taranaki and royal albatross feathers or toroa. These two symbols in this kete make it unique and distinctive.
- **\$2.70** Matthew McIntyre Wilson has created an extraordinary kete woven from silver and copper. The design depicted is entitled 'navigate the ocean' or 'aramoana' and its exemplary creation has lead to Matthew becoming renowned amongst the weaving fraternity.
- **\$3.30 A beautiful, delicate kete design by weaver Sonia Snowden.** The name of her kete is 'Tatai whetu ki te rangi', or 'clusters of stars in the heavens'.

Designed by Rangi Kipa and Roy McDougall, and printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin by offset lithography in the four process colours. Self-adhesive stamps printed on Tullis Russell 210gsm PSA red-phosphor self-adhesive stamp paper, diecut perfs p.9½x10 horizontal stamps and p.10x9½ vertical stamps, in sheets of 25 with vertical and horizontal roulettes and in jumboroll setenant blocks of six without roulettes. Gummed miniature sheets printed on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp paper, perf 13½.

New Discoveries

A puzzling watermark, a slanting booklet-pane and an amazing discovery. Three new items shown to us by CP Newsletter readers — thank you ... and please keep 'em coming.

First from Mr Martin Bridges of Derby, England comes a used copy of K13e 1925 King George V Surface ½d green Cowan perf 14x15. As Martin says: "This stamp has an extremely strange watermark." Looking from the back of the stamp the usual W.7 watermark is NZ over star (appearing reversed as we are looking from the back of the stamp). And the N on the right is normal. However the Z on the left appears to be reversed watermark, ie a normal right-way-round Z. How this can be is unclear. Watermark anomalies are known in the George V Surface issues, eg the 1d Field Marshal perf 14x15 is known both with the 'Z' of 'NZ' missing from the watermark, and with the Star of the watermark inverted. But this is the first time a similar watermark error has been reported on the ½d green and the first time that somehow the N and the Z appear together in differing orientations.

W145a 2014 "ANZAC V: WWII Poster Art" miscut booklet pane. Recently shown to us by Mr Don White of Dunedin Stamp Centre was a copy of this WWII Poster Art prestige booklet with a most interesting final pane.

Normally this booklet-pane SM1437/42 contains the six WWII Poster Art stamps arranged as in a miniature sheet, with the title lower right and a drawing of an NZ WWII soldier presenting arms at left.

This particular pane has been misguillotined at an angle revealing the white paper surround and guide-lines at top, right and bottom usually removed. A most interesting find and unlikely to be a one-off – other similar booklets are likely to be out there – worth checking yours!

And now something quite amazing: 1996 Health Teddy Bear miniature sheet First Day Cover. Yes, something not known to exist and probably unique: a Teddy Bear M/S FDC! Just to remind ourselves, the history of this issue is as follows: Two stamps on the theme of Road Safety were prepared for the 1996 Health issue. One depicted a girl and her parent safely crossing the road on a zebra crossing.

The other one showed a baby in a carseat with a teddy bear alongside the child. However this teddy bear was also wearing a seatbelt and thus both child and teddy bear were obviously facing forwards, which is against New Zealand child safety guidelines. The stamps were withdrawn and replaced by a redrawn design omitting the teddy bear. But, as is well known, some teddy bear stamps slipped through the system and were sold over the Post Office counters at Te Ngae PostShop in Rotorua and at Royal Oak PostShop in Auckland.

Up until now no miniature sheets incorporating the teddy bear stamps were known to have been sold in PostShops in New Zealand (a small number are known to have improperly originated from the Dutch printers Enschede). Now from Mr Murray King of Wakefield, New Zealand comes the report of the existence of a teddy bear miniature sheet on First Day Cover. This would appear in every respect to be identical to the regularly issued FDC – same FDC envelope and same Philatelic Bureau Wanganui NZ 5 June 1996 First Day of Issue postmark. Murray tells us he acquired the FDC a number of years ago from a collector, who in turn bought it in a lot of nine other FDC "in a car-boot sale in Wanganui in 1997."

What an extraordinary find And absolutely amazing what suddenly appears twenty years after issue!

James Berry Artist Drawings

6(a) Here is one further example of an original concept drawing from talented Wellingtonian artist James Berry. Berry's work in New Zealand stamp design is celebrated in a 1984 book "The Image Maker: the Art of James Berry, by JR Tye (Hodder and Stoughton).

This drawing was for the 3d value of the 1858-1958 Hawkes Bay Centennial stamp featuring Australian Gannets at Cape Kidnappers and a copy of the issued stamp is affixed under the drawing. Fascinatingly this original concept drawing was for a vertical stamp, rather than the horizontal one as issued.

The outline of rocky Cape Kidnappers is easily recognizable in both, as is the style of lettering, NEW ZEALAND, etc, and the 3d denomination but the positioning of the gannets themselves is quite different.
