# New Issue Notes

## Aurora Australis (Southern Lights) (8 February 2017)

Aurora was the Roman goddess of dawn, and appropriately enough often seen around dawn are luminous electrical radiations from the South Magnetic Pole – the Aurora Australis or Southern Lights.

More usually associated with Antarctica – and thus a Ross Dependency issue – this however is an attractive, brightly coloured, set of six stamps from New Zealand, more specifically from the summit of Mt John in the Mackenzie Basin, South Island. The Aoraki Mackenzie Basin International Dark-Sky Reserve is the largest dark-sky reserve in the world, established in June 2012, being completely devoid of man-made light.

Also pictured on four of the stamps and the miniature sheet is the University of Canterbury's Mt John Observatory. The stamps from this miniature sheet are printed using a special silver-foil, replicating the shimmering effects of the aurora. It is nice to have a miniature sheet that does not completely duplicate the set of stamps for a change and this one, and indeed the six sheet stamps, works well – a most pleasing set.

Designed by Jonathan Grey, New Zealand Post, Wellington; FDC photo by Dallas Poll and miniature sheet photo by Joel Gillespie. Printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin by offset lithography in the four process colours, perf 14½x14, six gummed stamps in sheets of 25 on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp-paper and a six stamp miniature sheet produced using a special silver-foil.

## Native New Zealand Freshwater Fish (1 March 2017)

More than forty native freshwater species have been identified in New Zealand. However, thirty of these natives are endangered due to various issues such as introduced predators (eg trout!), habitat destruction and man-made barriers on their migration routes (eg dams).

The five fish on the stamps are portrayed in an illustrative style on natural background colours. DOC (the Department of Conservation) has deemed each fish depicted to have a degree of rarity.

### Designs:

\$1.00 – Lowland Longjaw Galaxias, so named for its distinctive upturned lower jaw

\$1.80 – Redfin Bully or Toitoi, which has taught itself to climb above waterfalls, where it likes to live

\$2.20 – Longfin Eel or Tuna, can grow to over two-metres (over 6½ feet) in length and live for over 100 years

\$2.70 – Lamprey or 'vampire parasite', Kanakana or Piharau, has no jaw, instead has a round mouth lined with many sharp rasping teeth, with which they attach themselves to other fish

## **New Issue Notes (cont.)**

\$3.30 Torrentfish or Panoko, has a zebra-style camouflage for fast-flowing water and resembles its marine relative the blue-cod

There is also a five stamp shaped miniature sheet which is otherwise identical to the sheet stamps. However the stamps from the Freshwater Fish Limited Edition are different to the normal sheet stamps. These are from a special printing and have gloss coating highlights. This certainly does make the image of the fish stand out, especially the eel and the galaxias. This variation is footnoted in the CP Catalogue.

Designed by Stephen Fuller, Wellington and printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin by offset lithography in the four process colours, perf 14½x14. Five gummed stamps in sheets of 25 and a five-stamp miniature sheet on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp-paper.

## More New Discoveries

### NZ Second Sidefaces

From Mr John Geary of Dunedin comes a used ½d SSF perf 11 wmk W.4, which is D1e. This is clearly datestamped 26 Dec 1896 – thus the CP Catalogue date of ‘1897’ needs to be revised to ‘1896’.

### NZ Arms Type Fiscals

From Mr Arthur Willis of Sydney, Australia comes a used copy of Z31a 1931 2/6d deep brown Arms with an abnormal watermark variety. This stamp, whilst having the ‘Z’ normal, has the ‘N’ of the ‘NZ’ watermark reversed. Most unusual!

## 2017 NZ Post Postage Rates Increases

Saturday 1 July 2017 saw a range of postage rate increases. Fortunately Standard Post, which is \$1.00 medium, \$2.00 large and \$3.00 oversize, remains unchanged. There are increases however to FastPost rates as follows: medium up from \$1.80 to \$2.30, large up from \$2.80 to \$3.30 and oversize up from \$3.80 to \$4.30.

New stamps at \$2.30 and \$4.30 have already been produced, on 7 June 2017, for these new FastPost rates and extra printings made of the \$3.30 denomination. It will be interesting to see if new printings will also be required of the ‘make-up’ stamp 50c Lake Coleridge Canterbury.

Airmail rates for letters are unchanged, although Airmail parcels under 2kg have increased by an average of 4%

## **James Berry Artist Drawings**

A further selection of detailed pencil drawings from artist James Berry, all with a sporting theme:

- 124(a) 1967 Health: A pencil sketch, 15.2x21.3cm, on a larger sheet of tracing paper, on a rugby theme with an AllBlack kicking for a conversion. The sketch is surrounded by seven other smaller drawings, including a rugby ball and the Silver Fern. The sketch is inscribed "Postage 2½c, Health 1c" and is dated "1967" **\$600**
- (b) 1967 Health: A pencil sketch, 16.2x22.3cm, on a sheet of white art-paper, depicting a girl swimmer (actually quite similar to the 1968 Health 3c stamp, except that that was designed by LC Mitchell.) The drawing is inscribed "Postage 3½c, Health 1c" and is dated "1967" **\$600**
- (c) 1968 Health: A pencil sketch, 17.5x22.4cm, on a sheet of cream art-paper, depicting an Olympic swimmer. This was for the 1968 Mexico Olympic Games and the design includes the Olympic Rings. The drawing is inscribed "Postage 3½c, Health 1c" and is dated "1968" **\$600**
- (d) 1968 Health: A pencil sketch, 17.6x23.2cm, on a sheet of tracing paper, depicting an Olympic athlete. Again this was for the 1968 Mexico Olympic Games and is inscribed "Postage 2½c, Health 1c" and dated "1968". Unusually this drawing includes colour – the Olympic Rings are correctly coloured: blue, yellow, black, green, red, with the running-track behind the sprinter reflecting these colours. **\$800**
- (e) 1969 Health: A pencil sketch, 15.6x20.4cm, on a sheet of tracing paper, depicting a girls cricket team: a fielder, batswoman and wicket-keeper. The drawing is inscribed "Postage 3c, Health 1c" and is dated "1969" **\$600**

Once again CP Newsletter is delighted to offer this astonishing range of New Zealand errors and varieties. Many items offered are either unique or seldom seen – this is an extraordinary listing: please do not hesitate to order if you see something you want for your NZ stamp collection- they won't last long!

### 1898 Pictorials

- 120(a) E4a(1) 1900 1½d Boer War, a fine well-centred copy of the famous original Khaki shade. Has been hinged twice but otherwise clean gum and good perfs. A rare shade, always in demand. With Certificate [details] (Cat. \$6000)..... Mint \$3500
- (b) E4a(4) 1900 1½d Boer War perf 11, top right corner selvedge sheet serial number: 242131 block of four, with the four reentries: EV4b R1/11, EV4c R1/12, EV4e R2/11 and the well-known EV4f R2/12 nearly whole stamp exhibits reentry doubling, especially noticeable the rifle bayonet on right and central tents: the stamp has such an overall blurred appearance it really stands out in the block, LHM in selvedge only, stamps UHM (Cat. \$1100).....UHM \$600
- (c) E4b(2) 1907 1½d Boer War perf 14, the matching top right block of four with sheet serial number 236589, and naturally the same four plate-variety reentries, R1/11, R1/12, R2/11, R2/12. Once again the big reentry stamp jumps out at you! LHM in selvedge only, stamps UHM (Cat. \$1100)..... UHM \$500

- (d) N12a 1957 1/9d QEII black & orange top right corner selvedge block of four sheet value £14..... UHM \$50
- (e) N12b 1958 1/9d QEII as above sheet value =£14= no correction..... UHM \$100

### 1967 Pictorials

- (f) OD2a 1967 1c Karaka, extraordinarily angled misperfed single showing parts of four stamps..... UHM \$400

### 1970 Pictorials

- (g) P2c 1973 1c Red Admiral lower right corner selvedge block of four – a sheet corner fold before printing produces a truly wonderful item: a huge white void and part imperf on front, with missing design printed on reverse. UNIQUE.....UHM \$2500
- (h) P3b(x) 1973 2c Tussock Butterfly missing black: 'New Zealand' and butterfly body and outline missing (Cat. \$750)..... UHM \$500
- (i) P7a 1970 5c Scarlet Parrot Fish sheet value block of six with original (incorrect) "VALUE \$12.00" marking (Cat. \$600)..... UHM \$500
- (j) P9b(z) 1973 7c Leather Jacket left selvedge block of ten with left block of four complete double perfs. Scarce.....UHM \$500
- (k) P9b(y) 1973 7c Leather Jacket right selvedge strip of five with right stamp missing black, producing a strange looking 'eye-less' fish. (Cat. \$800)..... UHM \$600
- (l) P11b(x) 1974 8c John Dory single missing blue-green background (Cat. \$900).....UHM \$600

- 120(m) P12b(s) 1973 10c Queen top selvedge imperf pair. This is known to exist from Plate 2A4A (new Cat. \$700).....UHM \$500
- (n) P13b 1976 15c Maori Fish Hook, a left selvedge part sheet of forty including Plate 1A, with huge black ink splash over five stamps, obliterating most of design. Most unusual.....UHM \$750
- (o) P14b(x) 1974 18c Maori Club single missing black, no 'New Zealand' or carving on club (new Cat. \$1200).....UHM \$1000
- (p) P30b(u) 1971 4c overprint top selvedge block of four with major overprint shift, '4c' through perfs and partly on top selvedge, bars centre right (Cat. with '4c' completely on top selvedge \$2300)..... UHM \$500

### 1975 Pictorials

- (q) PA4a(x) 1975 4c Rose left selvedge block of ten, left block of four complete angled double perfs, also in left selvedge (Cat. \$1000)..... UHM \$750
- (r) PA7b(y) 1976 7c Rose top left corner selvedge block of ten, left block of four complete triple perfs, also in left selvedge, producing eight horizontal rows of perfs. Amazing (new Cat. \$900).....UHM \$750
- (s) PA32a(y) 1979 right selvedge block of four with prominent 17c albino surcharge clearly visible on reverse (Cat. \$1600).....UHM \$800

### Commemoratives

- (t) S103a(z) 1966 4d Scout Jamboree strip of five with missing gold on three units and partially missing on stamp five. This produces three stamps no gold arrowhead, crosses or stars. Very scarce missing colour error (Cat. \$10000).....UHM \$7500

NB If unsold we will consider breaking strip into:

- (i) S103a(z) Strip of three gold colour omitted pair with normal (Cat. \$6000).....UHM \$5000]
- (ii) S103a(z) Pair gold colour omitted and partial omission (Cat. \$4000).....UHM \$3500]
- (u) SM182-6(z) 1974 New Zealand day miniature sheet – horizontal grossly misguillotined miniature sheets are known; this is a vertically miscut miniature sheet, producing unprinted perfed stamp positions above, plus partial double perfs at top – Unbelievable!.....UHM \$2000
- (v) SS15a(z) 1974 18c White Island imperf at left with selvedge, fine perf error (Cat. \$750).....UHM \$600
- (w) S276/7(z) 1981 20c Royal Wedding pair silver-grey missing: no 'Royal Wedding 29 July 1981' inscription (Cat. \$2000).....UHM \$1250
- (x) SM367 1988 RPSNZ Centenary miniature sheet with \$1 stamp perfed impression doubled above it – this produces a 'ministamp' with 'NEW ZEALAND' only! Possibly Unique (small gum crinkles).....UHM \$1000

### Christmas

- (y) SC4a(v) 1963 2½d Christmas lower selvedge single with angled extra row of perfs. Unusual.....LHM \$300

- 120(z) SC16a(x) 1975 3c Christmas, a stunning complete sheet of 100, Plate 1A, with five (yes, 5!) impressions missing black, plus a further four black partially omitted. This produced no 'The Virgin and Child . Machiavelli' and huge changes to the painting, now with very bright colours. UNIQUE (new Cat. \$17500+).....UHM \$7500

### Health

- 121(a) TM30a(z) 1958 2d Brigade Children miniature sheet lower half of sheet unprinted. In fact all six stamps exhibit printing faults: faint partial prints top row, almost complete omission lower row, a remarkable printing error from Harrison and Sons Ltd, London. This is only the second miniature sheet of this nature we have seen in thirty years (Cat. \$3000).....UHM \$2500
- (b) T41b 1969 3c Cricket, a lower right corner selvedge block of eight, a cleaning-fluid splash affecting three stamps produces a circular area of bright pink and missing yellow- unique?.....UHM \$500
