New Issue Notes

Recovering Native Birds (2 August 2017)

This is an interesting, well researched and well designed set of stamps. Rather than just selecting five photogenic species of New Zealand birds, pictured here we have five native birds each at one time on the brink of extinction. The hard work of agencies such as the former Wildlife Service (until 1987) and DOC, the Department of Conservation, have rescued these native birds and they are now regarded as recovering species.

This is indeed fortunate as DOC estimates that 53 species of New Zealand native birds became extinct in the first 800 years of human contact, including many flightless birds such as the moa, adzebills, rails and ducks.

Each stamp incorporates litho varnish high-gloss finish giving conservation and recovery details of each native bird.

\$1.00 Campbell Island Teal. A flightless subspecies of brown duck once believed to be extinct. From less than thirty surviving birds, 150 were reintroduced to Dent Island, Campbell Island 2004-2006, and they now number more than 250 birds.

\$2.20 Black Stilt. This bright red-legged wader was reduced at one time to 23 birds. Extensive conservation techniques have seen the population rise to about 100 birds. It is confined to the South Island's Mackenzie Basin and is considered the world's rarest wading bird.

\$2.30 North Island Kaka. Not quite as endangered as the other natives here, this large olive-brown forest parrot, with red underwing features, the Kaka has increased from less than 3000 birds to more than 5000.

\$2.70 South Island Saddleback. From 36 birds to more than 1000, this has been a conservation success indeed. Still absent from the South and Stewart Islands, the rare black saddleback has chestnut saddle-markings and orange wattles and is now established on certain small predator-free islands.

\$3.30 Northern New Zealand Dotterel. This seabird has shown strong growth from 1350 birds in the 1990s to more than 2000 today. This rare wading bird is found on northern North Island sandy shores.

Designed by Jonathan Gray, New Zealand Post, Wellington and printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin by offset lithography in the four process colours with litho varnish high-gloss finish, five stamps perf 14½x14 in sheets of 25 and a five stamp miniature sheet perf 14, on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp-paper.

Maori Language Te Reo Maori (6 September 2017)

The Maori Language Commission Te Taura Whiri i Te Reo Maori and NZ Post have created ten stamps celebrating the growth and adaptability of the Maori language.

The first four \$1.00 stamps and the \$2.20 (setenant strip of five) feature 'A Day at Work'; the second four \$1.00 stamps and the \$2.70 (setenant strip of five) feature 'The Journey Home'.

The ten stamps each depict a modern word that has had a word created for it in te reo Maori.

\$1.00 stamps: mobile phone: waea pukoro; text: patuhi; computer: rorohiko (kupu huna); flashdrive: pumahara.

\$2.20 Wifi: Ahokore.

\$1.00 stamps: passport: uruwhenua; airport: taunga rererangi; global positioning system (GPS): punaha kimi ahunga; skyscraper; whare tikoke.

\$2.70 electric car: waka hiko.

This is an interesting issue that I am not sure completely works but an admirable effort tackling a difficult subject. Once again, regrettably, our country name is tucked away in tiny letters in the bottom right corner: NZ.

Designed by David Hakaraia and illustrated by Elisabeth Vullings, Wellington and printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin by offset lithography in the four process colours, perf 13½. A sheetlet of ten on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp-paper, a thicker paper with no show-through and with white gum. A setenant block of eight \$1.00 stamps and \$2.20 and \$2.70 singles, in three sheets of twenty, on a thinner paper showing the design through to the reverse with a blue-tinged gum.
