New Issues Round Up

2019 CAL Pack (30 June 2019)

(CALs Corner Part 67 – The Final Part)

A surprise announcement by New Zealand Post in early June 2019 that as from 30 June 2019 CALs would be no more. Personalised Postage Stamps would still be available in a similar format to CALs but would no longer be available from NZ Post in CAL Packs or on Year of Issue Covers.

Thus the final CAL Pack was released on 30 June 2019 comprising two self-adhesive CALs and twelve gummed CALs. There were twelve \$1.20 CALs and one CAL each at \$2.40 and \$3.00. The Year of Issue cover was dated 30 June 2019 Whanganui.

Colin McCahon 1919 – 1987 (3 July 2019)

Five stamps and miniature sheet commemorating the birth centenary in Timaru of New Zealand artist Colin McCahon. McCahon was a modernist and the five paintings selected reflect modernism and cubism.

- \$1.30 Titirangi Landscape (1954) oil on canvas
- \$2.60 The Angel of the Annunciation (1947) oil on cardboard

S1869a-S1873a, SM1869/73

Sir Edmund Hillary 1919 – 2008 (23 July 2019)

A setenant strip of five \$1.30 stamps commemorating a second 1919 birth centenary, that of Sir Edmund Hillary. Sir Ed is justifiably a Kiwi icon and these five stamps reflect his achievements of mountaineer and explorer.

- \$1.30 Mount Everest 1953
- \$1.30 South Pole Expedition 1958. Hillary, Murray Ellis and Derek Wright on tractors at the South Pole 20 January 1958
- \$1.30 Himalayan Trust 1961, Khumjung School
- \$1.30 Ocean to Sky 1977: River Ganges, India Jetboat Expedition from the mouth to the source of the Ganges

Designed by Helcia Berryman, Grange Park Creative, Raumatī South, Kapiti Coast and printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin, by offset lithography in the four process colours, perf 14, on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp-paper: five stamps in a setenant strip of five, in two different sheets of 25 (five sets): one with Value-block and barcodes (code NZ9K13SS); and one with silver-fern overprint on stamps, no Value-block or barcodes, top selvage with 'Souvenir Sheet [number] of 2019' (code NZ9KSVST)

New Issues Round Up (cont.)

New Zealand Rock Formations (“Rock Legends”) (7 August 2019)

This is very much an issue of two parts: nine most interesting stamps featuring a tour of unusual shaped New Zealand geological rock formations, surrounded by a dreadful sheetlet format full of the most awful puns and plays on words.

To quote NZ Post Collector’s notes: “Take a head-banging tour of New Zealand’s bold boulders and radical rock faces.” Groan!

Despite NZ Post stating that the Rock Legends stamp issue would be supplied as a full sheet of nine stamps and would not be available as single stamps, we understand from a number of sources that this is exactly what NZ PostShops were doing: removing the sheetlet’s selvedge and selling just the \$1.30 stamps.

Designs:

- Kaiaraara, ‘The Iron Duke’, resembling the Duke of Wellington, Northland
- Lion Rock, Piha, Auckland
- Elephant Rock, Taranaki. Sadly this rock formation has now lost its ‘Elephant trunk’ rock arch.
- Te Hoho Rock, Cathedral Cove, Coromandel
- Castlepoint Reef, Wairarapa
- Motukiekie, West Coast. An iconic sea-stack and bird sanctuary.
- Tunnel Beach, Otago – a huge cliff-face plus 1870 tunnel
- Punakaiki, West Coast limestone ‘pancakes’.
- Anapai Bay, Tasman (‘Photographer’s Rock’)

Designed by EightyOne Group, Wellington and printed by Southern Colour Print Ltd, Dunedin by offset lithography in the four process colours plus metallic gold, perf 14, on Tullis Russell 104gsm red-phosphor gummed stamp-paper, sheetlet of nine.

S1879a – S1887a, SM1879/87

Te Araroa Trail – The Long Pathway (4 September 2019)

Six most attractive stamps and miniature sheet featuring photos celebrating some of New Zealand’s best walking tracks, provided by walkers on the Te Araroa Trail. This Trail connects Cape Reinga at the top of the North Island to Stirling Point, Bluff at the bottom of the South Island, and is 3000 km long. In the 2018-2019 walking season more than 1100 people walked the length of the Te Araroa Trail.
