Editorial

October 10 saw Auckland City Stamps host Public Auction 19. New Zealand had been plunged into another, thankfully less severe, lock down in August and as we progressed through September, each drop in 'alert levels' meant more social freedoms – however we were unsure whether we would be in a position to hold a normal Public Auction or not. Thankfully Auckland went to Level 1 at 11.59pm on Wednesday October 7 and so viewing which started on Thursday October 8 and the auction itself were held under 'normal' circumstances. And what an Auction it was.

As soon as the catalogue went out we knew that the auction had been well received. Of particular interest was the large selection of very good collection lots with the postmark collections from the estate of the late Keith Richards tempting more than a few New Zealand collectors to ensure they attended the auction in person. We had a very large number of clients in for viewing in the lead up to Auction Day keeping David and the team very busy. The room itself on the day was full with in person and phone bidders as well as input from auction agent Mark Benvie. Many stayed right to the very last lot – not a frequent occurrence in philatelic auctions. As auctioneer, I had a great time and was very pleased with the 62% sale rate and some \$310,000.00 in sales on the day with many unsold items selling in the hours and days subsequent to the auction. It was great to see spirited bidding from the floor, the book and the phones on so many items – the market felt very active. Editorial (cont.)

As I said to the room on the day, over the past few months we have seen much increased interest in stamps and postal history – across the board from our clearance sales to our postal auctions and of course public auction 19 which had a very strong book with a great number of multiple bids across the auction. The interest has come from existing clients, new clients and many who are returning to the hobby. It seems that philately is not alone in experiencing much increased activity with the local art auction houses reporting similar growth and interest and items selling well above estimate. Based on what we are seeing David and I expect this to continue into 2021 and we have already accepted items for our next Public Auction. Certainly, if you have some good, quality single items or even a large holding we would love to hear from you and discuss how we can best assist with its sale.

We have two new discoveries to update CP clients on, both of which will be listed in the CP Catalogue. First is the 1961 Christmas 2 1/2d Adoration Missing Yellow a new discovery which will be listed in the catalogue as SC2a(w) which has a Royal Philatelic Society of New Zealand 2020 Certificate. We presently have an unhinged block of four available at \$3000.00. Please contact David at the office if you have interest in this item.

The second discovery was listed at Lot 5657 in our recent Public Auction 19 and was a complete sheet of 25 of the \$1.10 Queen Mother issue. The sheet had a Major Perforation Error with the top 5 stamps Missing the country name 'NEW ZEALAND' and the balance of the sheet of 20 stamps with a major perforation shift. This new discovery will be listed as S686a(z) with a catalogue value of \$5,000.00 per stamp, although this sheet is the only recorded example of these errors to date and is quite possibly unique.

As 2020 draws to a close we have made some decisions at CP around how our newsletter of offerings will look in the future. David and I have decided that we will publish this newsletter on a bi-monthly basis from now on. There are several reasons for this, first of all we have found that for many of our overseas clients one newsletter has been arriving in the post just as the next one is being mailed! Secondly and perhaps more pertinent is that as a small team we simply do not have the resource to publish a monthly newsletter along with everything else we do which includes postal auctions, public auctions, clearance sales, collection appraisals and of course face to face interactions with clients who pop in to see us at our Auckland office. This newsletter closes off 2020 and the next will be for January/February 2021. We'd like to take this opportunity to thank all our clients for their business during what has been an unusual and unpredictable year, to say the least. We wish each and every one of you the very best for the holiday season ahead and of course good health as the world continues to navigate the pandemic.
